ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED 2025-2026 BUDGET

RESOLVED, that the Deer Park Board of Education adopt the school district budget for the 2025-2026 school year, as presented, with the total appropriation of **\$153,320,108**. The budget will be submitted to the qualified voters in a referendum scheduled for Tuesday, May 20, 2025 that will be held at the Deer Park High School from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
